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Does this describe you?

Wouldn't it be good to understand it sooner, so you can get busy doing it?

God's will can be known in the Bible if you know where to look.

*"Having made known unto us the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself." – [Ephesians 1:9](#)*

First, God's will is not in your heart, it is in Jesus Christ, and people being in him ([Col 1:27-28](#)). When Christians ask to know God's will what they are really asking for is God's opinion about their circumstances as if he were a personal career counselor.

*"Dear God, I feel like I am not going anywhere in life, and I would really like to do something I like. Can you give me a great opportunity?"*

Actually, God already has a purpose: his own purpose. His will is for your salvation. If you have trusted the gospel you have al-

ready done half of God's will.

*"[God] will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth."*

The other half includes a lifelong process of you coming to a knowledge of the truth. This requires continual study of God's word, prayer, and work serving God ([2 Tim 2:15](#)).

When the word of truth becomes part of your inner man you gain wisdom. You learn skills to teach other people. You are equipped to live according to God's purpose in a time when the days are evil.

*"In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you." – [1 Thessalonians 5:18](#)*
